

### **40** FOR THE 10/40

### FORTY DAYS OF PRAYER FOR INDIGENOUS MISSIONS IN THE 10/40 WINDOW

**2 Billion people around the world have still not heard the gospel.** They are the unreached people groups of the world, meaning they have little to no access to the gospel, zero christian witness, or to other believers. 90% of the world's unreached people groups live in the 10/40 window.

### What is the 10/40 Window?

The 10/40 Window is the area of the world located between 10° and 40° latitude with countries that are majority Muslim, Hindu, and Buddhist. This is an incredibly difficult place for spreading the gospel message, due to persecution from the government and communities, lack of access to scripture, and extreme poverty levels. Though 90% of unreached people are living in countries in the 10/40 Window, **less than <1% of all missions giving** goes to these countries to further the spread of the gospel. You can help change that.




### What is 40 for the 10/40 missions compaign?

40 for the 10/40 is a campaign through **Partners International** that sets aside a period of forty days to mobilize churches to make a significant gospel impact worldwide. For four Sundays, beginning April 11th, we will be watching four videos that outline the global missions needs for the 10/40 window, and how our giving can make an impact in the least reached areas of the world. On **April 25th**, we will be hosting Rob Mullen from Partners International as a guest speaker during our morning worship service to consider how our church can make an impact in building the church in the least reached places.

#### Make a One-time Gift for Gospel Work in the 10/40 Window

On Sunday May 2nd, every church member will be challenged to give 40% of one day's income dedicated toward global gospel outreach within the 10/40 window. All gifts will go directly to dedicated ministry partners who are actively working to reach the unreached with the gospel of Jesus Christ.
