Associate Pastor Search Update

TO GOD'S GLORY AND THE GOOD OF HIS CHURCH

The office of pastor encompasses many responsibilities. As we look to Scripture, we discover that pastors have four primary responsibilities including: *leading* under the authority of Christ (Acts 20:28), *caring* for the body of Christ (1 Peter 5:1-4), *teaching* the Word of Christ (1 Timothy 3:2), and *modeling* the character of Christ (Titus 1:6-9).

The Scriptures describe how pastors serve as under-shepherds to the Chief Shepherd, the Lord Jesus Christ. The ministry of an under-shepherd is not simply a job, but rather it is a vocation, the answering of a specific call from God.

We are prayerfully looking for someone to join our pastoral team. The position we are seeking is a full-time Associate Pastor to fill the role of Students & Mobilization. This position serves within the pastoral leadership team to develop, promote, and execute a comprehensive program for student ministries (children to college-age) as well as oversee the development, life and direction of the ministries of the church, so that they fulfill our mission and reflect our core values.

We are prayerfully trusting God's guidance for who He has for us. As we continue our staff search, we invite you to join us in three specific ways.

First, to pray. Ask the LORD for godly wisdom and spirit-filled discernment to surround our associate pastor search committee. The associate pastor search committee consists of Leah Finch (Chair), Eric Daniels, Tim McClure, Debbie Ronk, Justin St. Clair, and our Senior Pastor, Aaron Mansfield.

Second, to trust. Trust in the Spirit of God's leading for His congregation. Trust the process and those appointed by the congregation to serve in this process.
