As of that evening, the goal had been tremendously surpassed with an offering total of \$27,592! Praise God for His great provision through the generosity of those who gave! Altogether, the church will put at least \$50,000 down towards the purchase of the new property. A quarter of the property is already paid for, praise God!

A designated "building fund" has been established for the purpose of the property and future development. You may continue to designate special gifts toward the property at any time. Any gifts received before closing will be applied toward the down payment.

# **CONNECTING THE DOTS**

#### Developing a pivotal partnership with Mission Link International

Missions has always been an important part of Catawba Valley Baptist Church since it's beginning. A number of years ago, Catawba Valley was introduced to the ministry of MLI. Over the years, this has developed into a relationship that has enabled **eight individuals** from our church to experience overseas missions in East



In 1998, under the direction of **Dr. Rick Sadler**, MLI was officially established as a non-profit ministry in the Commonwealth of Virginia. Over the last two decades MLI has organized, developed, and nurtured ministries in East Africa. MLI is the *link* whereby churches and individuals can support indigenous missions throughout the region of East Africa in order to see nationals reach their country for Christ.

**Richard Caldwell** had the opportunity to experience Uganda, Africa for the first time in February 2014 after hearing Dr. Rick Sadler present the ministry of MLI at a Sunday morning missions emphasis service at CVBC. God has given Richard a passion to declare His glory among the nations! Throughout his life, Mr. Richard has experienced the work of global missions firsthand through different global trips sent from CVBC. It was Richard's presentation at a Family Mission Night shortly after his trip that began to ignite the spark for others to return the following year. Mr. Richard has been on every trip the church has taken since 2014.

The following year, in February 2015, Mr. Richard along with three other individuals from CVBC (Jared Micek, Molly Clemons, and Marshall Cantrell) were a part of the medical mission trip coordinated by MLI. That year, the ladies from the church began sewing dresses and clothing to take on the trip. Hundreds of Africans came through the medical mission tent, with a number of people trusting Christ as their Savior! This trip solidified the church's collective desire to begin partnering with MLI in a more formative way.

The following year, Mr. Richard along with two others (**Leigh Ogle** and **Jordan Ogle**) experienced the red dusty roads of East Africa. The team in 2017 participated in another large medical mission endeavor. The 2018 February trip, included a smaller team along with Mr. Richard and **Pastor Stephen Vaughan**. This team focused on evangelism and church strengthening by holding large gospel crusades with the network churches of MLI.

Last year, in 2019, **Pastor Aaron Mansfield** and Richard Caldwell had the opportunity to travel with the annual MLI mission team. Since that trip, God's leading has confirmed a more amazing opportunity for our church. In recognizing our commission to make disciples of all nations, we must evaluate the ministries and unique gifting distinctive to our congregation to understand our specific part in advancing God's kingdom in this generation.

As we consider what God has entrusted to us, we believe our relationship with Mission Link is not by coincidence. It is from this conviction, that with much prayer and consideration, the leadership of our church envisions **creating a more pivotal partnership** with Mission Link International this coming year. In the days ahead, more information will be provided concerning this exciting endeavor.
