Introducing your Quiet Time

a special time that you set aside each day to read God's Word, to get to know Him better, and to learn how He wants you to live. During this time, God speaks to you through His Holy Word, the Bible, and you speak to God through prayer. What an adventure! As a Christian, spending this time in God's Word every day is very important for you to grow closer to Him.

This booklet is divided into two sections:

Personal Prayer Diary

where you can write prayer requests to remind yourself to pray for people that you care about and things that are happening.

Quiet Time Activity Pages

where creative activities challenge you to understand the truths from the Bible every day.



Hey, Parents! This Quiet Time is a great opportunity for you to have fun together with your child. Here are some tips to help your child get the most out of their time in God's Word.

- Sit down with your child around the same time each day.
- Gather supplies needed for activities.
- Use the Bible to look up references together.
- Talk through the activity and personal application.
- Encourage your child to use the prayer suggestions in the Pray section and pray with them.
- Complete the week by documenting how many days were completed and writing an encouraging note.

There is a Word of Life Quiet Time available for every person in your family! Look up Family Devotionals at wolstore.org. Since all the Quiet Times are based on the same Scripture passage each day, it's a great way to get the whole family talking about what they're learning from God's Word.





Praise Jesus for being so wonderful!




Church should be a place of prayer, singing, learning God's Word, and other acts of worship. Church should never be a place of lying, stealing, and cheating.

Listen to others when they correct you, so you can be more like Jesus and not like the Pharisees. Circle the 5 things that are wrong with this picture.




THURSDAY MATTHEW 22:14



Not Fair Pharisees


Jesus said to love God and love people. The Pharisees wanted to be in charge and be noticed by others. The Pharisees loved themselves, not God and people.

Draw a line to the One you should want to please.





TUESDAY






FRIDAY

You have choices to make in life.




Jesus suffered for your wrong choices. You must choose between good and bad. You make right choices when you choose to follow God.


WEDNESDAY

You need to say NO to temptation. Circle the NO's hidden in this picture.




SATURDAY
