Property Update

Our new property on Rt. 311 is under contract!

This property is truly an answer to prayer for greater opportunities to minister to our growing congregation as well as provide a larger venue for ministry, outreach, and furture growth. A designated "building fund" has been established for the purchase of the property and future development. The cost of the property is \$200,000. During the morning service on Sunday, **January 26** there will be a special one-time offering to go towards the down-payment. **What would you prayerfully give to this special project?**

UGANDA 2020

In June our church will send two mission teams to Uganda, East Africa. The mission trip will be in two phases: **June 4-18** will consist of an intensive five day pastor's conference for about a dozen men to provide additional theological training. The second phase, **June 13-26** will be a church team, led by Pastor Stephen Vaughan. The team focuses will include hosting an International Prayer Advance with Christ-life Ministries, holding evangelistic crusades on Buvuma Island, interacting with deaf children at the Kamuli Deaf School serving street kids, sharing with patients at Jinja Hospital, ministering to widows, and other various projects!

ADVANCING GOD'S MISSION

Developing a partnership with Mission Link International

Missions has been an important part of Catawba Valley Baptist Church since it's beginning. A number of years ago, Catawba Valley was introduced to the ministry of Mission Link International (MLI). Over the years, this has developed into a relationship that has enabled eight individuals from our church to experience overseas missions in Uganda, East Africa.

In 1998, under the direction of Dr. Rick Sadler, MLI was officially established as a non-profit ministry in the Commonwealth of Virginia. Over the last two decades MLI has organized, developed, and nurtured various ministries in East Africa. The goal of MLI is to see nationals reach their country for Christ. MLI is the *link* whereby churches and individuals can support indigenous missions throughout the region of East Africa. The primary emphasis of MLI is to train national pastors and church leaders in the Bible. Additionally, MLI is actively involved with: ministering to African widows, supporting a deaf school, serving street kids, funding medical missions, constructing churches and houses, and hosting a number of other ministries and projects.

Christ's commission to His church is "make disciples of all nations." As such, each follower of Christ has been individually created, called, and commissioned by God to make disciples of all nations. God has a plan and purpose for each individual life. He's the Great Architect of His church. He's the One who has drawn the blueprint, and as living stones each member of the body has a part to play in the building. In world missions we enter into partnership with those ministering overseas and together are "God's fellow workers" in advancing His Kingdom.

In February of 2019, Pastor Aaron Mansfield and Richard Caldwell had the tremendous opportunity to travel with the annual MLI mission team. It was during this mission trip, that God reignited a passion for world missions in Pastor Aaron's life, and reconfirmed the immense impact that is made when the church rallies around the mission mandate given by Christ to His church. It was also during this trip, that Pastor Aaron was approached about possibily being the next missions director for Mission Link International. In Pastor Aaron's own words, "I didn't come to Africa looking for a ministry." After much prayer and consideration, God's leading has reaffirmed Pastor Aaron's call to the pastorate; while at the same time giving him a burden to see the church own it's responsibility to make disciples of all nations. In a miraculous way, God's leading over the past number of months has confirmed a more amazing opportunity for our church.

It is in recognizing our commission to make disciples of all nations, that we must evaluate the ministries and unique gifting distinctive to our congregation to understand our specific part in advancing God's kingdom in this generation. As we consider what God has entrusted to us, we believe our relationship with Mission Link is not by coincidence. It is from this conviction, that with much prayer and consideration, the leadership of our church envisions creating a more pivotal partnership with Mission Link International this coming year. In the days ahead, more information will be provided concerning this exciting endeavor.
